

Introduction

- The 'Holy Place' was only for the priests to enter.
- A rectangular chamber 10 x 10 x 20 cubits: 2,000 cubits cubed.
- Sides of acacia wood overlaid with gold.
- A veil at the far end concealed the 'Holy of Holies'.
- The 'Holy Place' was home to -
- (i) the Lampstand (Menorah);
- (ii) the Table of Showbread; and
- (iii) the Altar of Incense.

1 The MAKING of the Lampstand

- · No Biblical measurements.
- Tradition: 5 feet tall and 31/2 feet wide.
- Constructed from solid piece of gold weighing 43 Kg.
- Central stem from which protruded 6 branches.
- At top of stem and branches an oil lamp was placed.
- All parts counted together made 66.

2 The MAINTENANCE of the Lampstand

- Lamps never to go out. [Exodus 27:20]
- Wicks trimmed and oil replenished each day. [Exodus 30:7]

3 The MEANING of the Lampstand

Remember: The Tabernacle and Furnishings are Types/Pictures.

(i) The Lord Jesus Christ

- Made of precious gold. [I Peter 2:7]
- Seven lamps: 7 is the number of perfection.
 - Christ is Perfect Man and Perfect God.
- Made of 'beaten' or 'hammered' gold.
 - For Christ's work to be realized,
 - He was beaten beyond belief.
 - [Matthew 26:67]; [Matthew 27:26]; [Isaiah 52:14]
- 'I am the Light of the world'. [John 8:12]

(ii) The Scriptures of Truth

- Sixty-six parts made a whole Lampstand,
 Sixty-six Books make a complete Bible. [Psalm 119:105]
- His Word chases away the darkness of ignorance and error.
- Satan is constantly attempting to extinguish the lamps.
- 'post tenebras lux'.

(ii) The Believer and the Church

- See [Matthew 5:14] and [Revelation 1:20]
- · Shine where God has placed you.
- We shine in three ways –
- a) by making known His Gospel;
- b) by being upright in character (trim the wicks and have a constant supply of fresh oil);
- c) by doing good to all. [Matthew 5:14]

Finally -

- Everything in the Holy Place is by design not by accident.
- The 2,000 cubits cubed is a picture of the church age.
 Imagine no Lampstand in the Holy Place!
- He has called us to light up our age.
