#### Introduction

- Genesis 3 records the 'saddest day in history.'
- This chapter is one of the most important in the whole Bible.
- It reveals the origins of evil, sin, ruin and misery, suffering and death.
- It also lays the foundation for the gospel.

## 1 God's Right To Be God

- As God, Jehovah has the right to do and say as He pleases. [Psalm 115:3].
- As a test of their love and obedience God puts just one restriction on our first parents. [2:16 17].

### 2 The First Question In The Bible

- Satan asks the first question in the Bible which is an attack on the character and the Word of God.
- He is still doing so today.

#### 3 The Temptation Of Mother Eve

- The 'tempter' comes to tempt Eve.
- Definition of temptation: The desire to do something wrong and the inclination to sin.
- Temptation is something we all encounter. Even Jesus experienced it. [Matthew 4].
- Adam & Eve were created with the ability not to sin and the ability to sin.
- They yielded to the temptation by their own wilful voluntary choice.

#### 4 Eye Gate And Ear Gate

- According to Bunyan in the classic 'Holy War' there are 5 gates that lead to your soul that need guarded.
- 'Eye' 'Ear' 'Mouth' 'Nose' and 'Feel Gates.'
- Eve didn't guard the first two and Satan rode right into her soul. [Genesis 3:6].
- 'Be careful little eyes what you see. Be careful little ears what you hear.'
