Introduction

- Genesis 1 - 11 record 4 great events.
- The Flood of Noah's day is the 3rd of them.

1 The Fact Of Noah And The Flood

- Noah is mentioned 54 times in the Bible.
- [Luke 3:36] includes him in the family tree of the Lord Jesus.
- Jesus referred to him in his preaching as well as confirming the Flood.

2 The Time Of The Flood

- [Genesis 5] is a most important chapter although it might not appear to be so on the surface.
- The average age of a person pre-flood was 912. (Amazing).
- The Flood took place 1656 years after God created Adam and Eve.
- Noah lived on a young earth.

3 What Was Noah's World Like?

- The geography and climate was different to what it would be post Flood.
- Humanity was vegetarian in diet. [Genesis 9:3].
- Noah's world was an overcrowded world. [Genesis 6:1].
- Noah's world was a wicked and violent world [Vs 5 & 11].
- The '*sin virus*' had spread.
- Noah's world was earmarked for judgement. [Vs 7].
- Noah's world is just like our world. [Acts 17:31].

5 Noah Found Grace [Vs 8]

- Grace is mentioned 170 times in the Bible.
- Undeserved favour. [Ephesians 2:8].
- Noah was just as bad as the next person but grace found him.
- Grace is scandalous.
- Grace turned Noah into a just and perfect man. Grace changed him.
- '*Amazing Grace! How sweet the sound, that saved a wretch like me!*'
