Introduction

- This chapter is history foretold before the event.
- History is not a haphazard collection of chance events taking us nowhere.
- It is a divine masterplan taking us to the greatest event yet in history.
- Chapters 11 & 12 foretell events from Daniel's time until the return of Christ.

1 The PERSIAN Era [Verses 1 - 2]

2 The GREEK Era [Verses 3 - 4]

• The empire divides into 4 individual kingdoms.

3 The RIVALRY Between the Kings of the North and the kings of the South [Vs 5 - 30]

• Especially the exploits of Antiochus the Great & Antiochus Epiphanes.

4 The Pagan ROMAN Era [Vs 31 - 33]

- The 'abomination of desolation.' What is it?
- Antiochus Epiphanes or a future antichrist? No!
- Compare [Matthew 24:15] and [Mark 13:14] with [Luke 21:20].
- It is the Roman armies in the temple defiling the temple site and leading to the desolation of the Jews in AD70.
- [Vs 32] "Those who do wickedly." = the unbelieving Jews.
- "Those who know their God and do exploits." = the early church.
