Introduction

- In [Ch 17] David is our hero and makes us proud.
- In [Ch 21] he disappoints us and lets us down.
- · We realise that our hero has feet of clay.
- He's in a panic. He's on the run. He's desperate.
- In the 2nd half of the chapter he blots his copybook even further.

1 "....For Fear...."

- There is a difference in the translation of [vs 10] between versions.
- The AV inserts the phrase 'for fear.'
- Fear: 'an unpleasant emotion caused by the threat of danger, pain or harm'.
- It is used in the Bible some 404 times.
- There is no record of 'fear' prior to 'the Fall'. It's a consequence of humanity's sin.
- There is a fear that is good. [Proverbs 1:7]
- The other fear is to be overcome.
- Consider: [2 Timothy 1:7] 'fear' is a spirit.
- Consider also [Psalm 34:4], [Psalm 56:3], [Isaiah 41:10, [Psalm 23:4].
- Overcoming fear is through developing a consciousness of God's presence.
 (Immanuel).
- When you are afraid, you often act out of character.

2 David Went To The World/Ungodly For Help [Vs 10]

- David went over the border into enemy territory.
- He sought sanctuary amongst the godly.
- Be careful who you go to for help when you are in trouble.
- David is quickly identified in Gath.
- The Philistines even acknowledged David as the future king of Israel.
- David feared they were going to kill him.

3 David, The Actor

- David pretended he was having a fit, that he was like one possessed.
- In [Ch 18] 4 times we read of David behaving wisely. This time he behaves most unwisely. [vs 13].
- David played the part. He acted. He should have received an Oscar.
- A hypocrite is an actor.
- The word 'hypocrite' is used 31 times in the Bible.
- **Lesson**: Be what you really are. Don't pretend/act to be someone you're not.
