Introduction

- The Kingdom of God' is also referred too as 'the Kingdom of Heaven.'
- The words kingdom/kingdoms are used 399 times in the Bible.
- In the 4 gospels they are used 129 times.

1 Usages Of The Term In Matthew

• [Matthew 3:1 - 2], [4:17], [5:3], [5:10], [6:9 - 10], [6:33], [10:7].

NB In [Matthew 13] 6 parables begin with the phrase 'the Kingdom of heaven is like.'

2 Usage Of The Term In Mark

• [Mark 10:14], [12:34], [14:25], [15:43].

3 Usage Of The Term In Luke

• [Luke 1:31 - 33], [4:43], [9:62], [17:21], [23:42].

4 Usage Of The Term In John

• [John 3:3,5], [18:36].

5 Usage Of The Term In The Rest Of The New Testament

[Acts 8:12], [Acts 28:30 ~ 31], [1 Corinthians 6:9 - 10],
 [2 Timothy 4:1 & 4:18], [Revelation 11:15].

NB These texts suggest this Kingdom is something past, present and future? How come?

6 There Are Different Kingdoms

- There are the kingdoms of men or earthly kingdoms. [Luke 4:5].
- These kingdoms eventually fade away.
- Satan also has a kingdom. [Matthew 12:26].
- Satan's kingdom permeates through the worldly kingdoms opposing God's rule.
- There is also God's Kingdom.

7 Notice How The Bible Talks About TWO Ages

- There is this 'present age.' From creation up until the return of Christ.
- There is also 'the age to come.' This starts with Christ's return and goes on forever.

8 Definition Of The Word 'Kingdom.'

 Translated from the Greek word 'basileia' meaning 'the reign/rule of God.'

NB 'Thy Kingdom Come.' The next line defines it. 'Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.'

- The Kingdom of God is anywhere were the will of God is perfectly done.
- When we say, 'not my will but Your will be done,' our heart is then a little enclave of the Kingdom of God now.

Chorus:

Reign in me, sovereign Lord reign in me.
Captivate my heart, let your Kingdom come,
Establish there your throne and let your will be done.
