Introduction

- Christian and Hopeful take a shortcut and unwittingly find themselves trespassing in the grounds of '*Doubting Castle*.'
- They fall asleep and are awakened by Giant Despair who lives in the castle.
- He throws them into a dungeon in the castle and beats them mercilessly.
- 1 Christians And Doubting Castle
- Every Christian at some point find themselves incarcerated for a time in '*Doubting Castle*.'
- Definition of Doubt: 'A mental state in which the mind remains suspended between two or more positions.'
- It means, 'to be uncertain.'

- David (before he was king) spent a while in '*Doubting Castle*.' [1 Samuel 27:1].
- Thomas the disciple also. [John 20:24 29].
- John the Baptist too [Matthew 11:3].
- **Question:** Are you '*doubting*' tonight? Perhaps doubting your salvation or if God's forgiven you?
- Question: How's you own spiritual mental health?

2 Surviving 'Doubting Castle'

- The pilgrims made up their minds not to give in.
- They encouraged each other when the other was at a low point.
- They encouraged themselves by reminding themselves what God had already brought them through.
- The memories of yesterday's victories became their foundation for today's successes.

- The key represents the promises of God. [2 Corinthians 1:20] and [2 Peter 1:4].
