[PART 6] OLIVET'S PROPHECIES -FULFILLED OR FUTURE (3)

Exposition Of Matthew 24: 21 - 28

Introduction

- The disciples asked Jesus 2 very important questions.
 - When will these things be? (The destruction and desolation of the temple.) - What will be the sign of Your coming (Parousia) and of the end of the age?
- Jesus sets about answering those questions in the remainder of the chapter (vs 4 51).
- There are 2 types of prophecies: those that have been fulfilled and those that are still to be fulfilled.
- Both types of prophecies are in this chapter.
- In [vs 4 21] Jesus answers the 1st question.
- [Vs 22] is the transition from the 1st to the 2nd question.
- [vs 22 ~ 26] cover the church age from AD70 until Christ's return.

1 Read [Vs 21]

- "For then there will be great tribulation..."
- The tribulation initially refers to the slaughter of the unbelieving Jews in AD70 by the Roman legions.
- This is confirmed by Dr Luke's parallel account in [Luke 21:24].

2 The Times Of The Gentiles

- A period of time when Gentile powers exercised rule over Jerusalem beginning with Nebuchadnezzar's Babylon followed by the Persians, the Greeks and then the Romans when the NT era commences.
- After the Romans it was the Arabs/Saracens/Muslims.
- For 400 years prior to 1917 it had been held by the Turkish Ottoman empire.

• The 'times of the Gentiles' finished in 1917 when it was liberated by the British paving the way for the Jews to return.

3 What Do We Mean By 'Tribulation?'

- In the Olivet Discourse the word 'tribulation' is used 3 times. NKJV [vs 9[, [vs 21] & [vs 29]
- It is used 26 times in Bible.
- Translated from the Greek word 'thlipsis.'
- Futurists teach '*the tribulation*' is still in the future and the church will **NOT** experience it.
- They say that only those left behind when the 'Rapture' happens will face it from a future 'antichrist'.
- NB. The church will not miss the tribulation. Consider [John 16:33] & [Acts 14:22].
- The church has endured tribulation since its beginning.
- The Jews, the pagan Romans, papal Rome, Communist regimes and currently from Islam.
- The Futurist's denial that the church will go through the tribulation denies the teaching of Jesus and ignores the facts of history.
- [Vs 21 26] concern the church age from AD70 until Jesus returns.

4 Who Are The False Christ's

- Consider [vs 23/24].
- There is only one Christ. All others who claim to be a Christ are frauds and imposters.
- NB. The Papacy had consistently asserted that the popes of Rome are Christ under the veil of the flesh. Blasphemy!!!!
- A deception that has deceived untold millions.
- Don't be deceived by them and their superstitious beliefs.

5 Read [Vs28]

- This is a picture of divine judgement.
- Carrion birds circling dead or dying prey.
- It happened at AD70 and will happen again at Christ's return.

Finally

- Judgement of Sodom/Gomorrah didn't happen until Lot and his family were safely away.
- The judgement in AD70 was held back until the Christians had fled the city.
- The final judgement will only take place once the elect have been taken out of the world at the Rapture.
