

Reading: **Matthew 24:29 - 31** 

## Introduction

- In the opening verses of Matthew 24, Jesus has foretold the destruction of the temple.
- In response to that, the disciples ask Jesus 2 questions:
  - 1. When will these things be? (the end of the temple) and
  - 2. What will be the sign of your coming and of the end of the age?
- Two separate questions about the end of two separate things.
- In [vs 4 20] Jesus answers their 1st question.
- In [vs 21 28] He deals with the era between the end of the temple in AD70 and the end of the age.
- In [vs 29 31] He deals with His coming at the end of the age.

## 1. Jesus Is Coming Again

- History is NOT a haphazard collection of chance events taking us nowhere.
- It is taking us to the climax & culmination of the ages the glorious return of the Lord Jesus in power and glory.
- He is coming to set up His kingdom, defeat His enemies, destroy the devil and restore paradise lost.
- This is the blessed hope of the church.

## 2 The Creeds Of The Church

- All the historical church creeds of the church declare their belief in Christ's return.
- The word 'creed' comes from the Latin word 'credo' meaning 'I believe and trust.'
- This shows the teaching of Christ's return is not some new doctrine but an old one.

## 3 The Coming Or Parousia Of Jesus Christ

- The words 'coming' or 'come' or 'comes' occur 10 times in Matthew 24.
- The term 'the Coming' occurs 3 times in [vs 27, 37 and 39]. In these 3 instances it is the Greek word 'Parousia.'
- It is used of someone's presence or arrival.
- Used of an invading army or the arrival of a king to one of his provinces.
- When used of a visiting king, the leading citizens would go out to meet the king and return with him.
- Futurists teach that there are 2 returns of Christ. Firstly coming for His church and then 7 years later coming with His church back to earth.
- They say that His 1st of these 2 comings will be secret, the world not knowing what has happened.
- During the 7 years the believers are in heaven.
- On earth a temple is rebuilt and an antichrist arises and sits in temple to be worshipped.
- Those who refuse will suffer persecution and tribulation.
- After the 7 years, Jesus returns with us to destroy antichrist. This theory implies not just a 2nd coming but a 3rd.
- There is nothing of this in the text of Matthew.
- [Vs 29] Immediately after the tribulation of the church age.
- [Vs 30] There is nothing secret about His coming in this verse. Its very visible.
- The whole world will witness it. [Revelation 1:7].
- Consider [1 Thessalonians 4:16/17]. The noisiest verses in the Bible and the 'rapture' happens in the middle of it.
- A great shout and the trumpet of God. Nothing secret here.
- "He will send His angels with a great sound of a trumpet."
- Christ will come at the head of legions of angels. Consider [James 5:4].
- They are coming to "gather 'His elect" and rapture them to meet the Lord in the air.
- Consider [1 Thessalonians 4:16/17] and [Psalm 91:11].
- The end of the age is harvest time and the reapers are the angels.
- The Rapture will facilitate the greatest 're-union' of all time. The dead in Christ
  now resurrected with the living believers.
- · 'What a day that will be when my Jesus I shall see.'
- "Forsaking not the assembling of ourselves together as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another and so much the more as you see the Day approaching."

[Hebrews 10:25].
