

Reading: Revelation 21:1 - 5

Introduction

- We are currently considering the question, 'What will the Kingdom of Heaven be like when Jesus comes again?'
- The 'Kingdom of Heaven' is the Kingdom of God set up on a new earth.
- To enter it one needs to be 'born again' as Jesus said in [John 3:3].
- Nothing sinful or unrighteous will enter this Kingdom.
- It will be a Kingdom of Peace.
- It will be made possible because Satan will be bound and cast into the bottomless pit. [Revelation 20:1 3].

1 It Will Be A Kingdom Of Health

- All Jesus' miracles were a foretaste of what the Kingdom would be like. [Luke 11:20].
- There will be no cancers or tumours.
- There will be no heart disease.
- There will be no mental health issues.
- No plagues or pandemics.
- No respiratory illnesses.
- · No diseases affecting the animal world.
- No pills and potions. No hospitals.
- 'Jehovah Rapha' (the Lord our God who heals you) will be on the throne.
- It will be the 'time of restitution of all things' and that includes the restitution of divine health. [Acts 3:21].

2 It Will Be A Kingdom Of Life

- Consider [Revelation 21:4] "There shall be no more death."
- · No miscarriages or cot deaths.
- · No suicides or euthanasia.
- No post mortems or coroners inquests or funerals.
- The Giver of Life and the Conqueror of death will be on the throne. [Revelation 21:4].

3 The Kingdom Will Be Teeming With Children

- Consider [Isaiah 11:6 9].
- NB. 'a little child.....nursing child.....weaned child.'
- Consider also the words of Jesus in [Matthew 19:14].
- Question: Where do all these children come from?
- Children born of Christian women who were pregnant at the time of Christ's coming.
- Children at the time of Christ's coming who had not come to the age of understanding.
- Children resurrected at Christ's coming who had died in infancy.
- Children who were a 'miscarriage' or a 'still birth'. [Eccles 3:11].
- Children who were 'aborted.'
- NB. Since the introduction of the 'Abortion Bill' in 1967 over 10 million babies have been aborted in the UK.
- Not wanted or loved on earth but wanted and loved by Christ.

4 A Kingdom Where Animals Are At Peace

- In Genesis 1 God made the animals before humanity.
- In the Kingdom the very nature of the animal world will be changed.
- Consider again the text of [Isaiah 11:6 9].
- · Animals wont be abused or neglected.
- All creation will be at peace and will live in peace.
- · That's my home and where I want to live.
