

Reading: Luke 1:26 - 33

Introduction

- We are currently looking at what 'the Kingdom of heaven' on earth will be like when Jesus comes again.
- It will be a kingdom of peace and righteousness.
- · Nothing that defiles will enter it.
- There will be no more tears, pain, curse or death.

1 The King And His Coronation

- The Kingdom will be ushered in with a coronation.
- We saw on TV the coronation of their majesties King Charles III and Queen Carmilla on 6th May 2023.
- It was attended by members of other royal families and heads of states and beamed around the world by TV.
- Every citizen will be invited to the earthly coronation of King Jesus.
- The Kingdom of heaven will be a Kingdom, not a republic.
- Christ will be given the 'throne of His father, David.'
- This throne is 'the throne of the kingdom of the LORD....' [1 Chronicles 28:5].
- King Jesus will be 'anointed' as was the custom in Israel.
- **NB.** The British monarch is the only monarchy that anoints their new sovereign.
- The oil used was from the olive groves around Bethlehem.
- The British monarch is a 'constitutional' monarchy.

- The monarchy of the Kingdom of heaven will be an 'absolute' monarchy.
- There will be no protests at His coronation.

2 The Kingdom Will Have A Government

- Consider [Isaiah 9:6 7].
- Notice 'the government' and 'His government.'
- Just as an earthly government runs a country, so government of the Kingdom of heaven will implement the policy of King Jesus.
- The government of the Kingdom will have a 'cabinet.' See [Matthew 19:28] and [Revelation 21:14].
- This government will also have countless '*rulers*' to assist with the smooth running of the Kingdom. [Matthew 25:21,23], [Luke 19:17, 19].
- There will be cities in the Kingdom with designated 'rulers.' Will you be one?

3 The Kingdom Will Have An Award's Ceremony

- Consider the texts, [Romans 14:10] and [2 Corinthians 5:10].
- **NB.** The 'Great White Throne' Judgement of [Revelation 20] is the judgement of the unsaved and the ungodly.
- This is the 'reckoning' or 'assessment' of the believer in the Kingdom.
- This is not about answering for our sins. They have been forgiven and the debt incurred by them paid by Christ.
- In Roman towns/cities before the governors residence a 'bema seat' was positioned.
- This was were citizens were rewarded, usually with a laurel wreath crown publicly bestowed on them.
- Something similar happens in the Kingdom when we are called to give an account of our service to the Lord in this life.
- Faithfulness is a highly rewarded thing.
- What have we done and what are we doing for the Kingdom now?
- There are 4 crowns available. [1 Corinthians 9:24/25], [2 Timothy 4:8], [1 Peter 5:4] and [Revelation 2:10].
- Warning: [Revelation 3:11]. Don't lose your crown to another.
- The 'Bema Seat' is also were wrongs will be righted publicly.
- Our 'reckoning' will also take into account how much we knew.
- Our 'reckoning' will also take into account our MOTIVES.
