## Introduction

- "It is important church that you should have clear knowledge on the subject of Bible prophecy especially regarding the 'end times."
- Why is there a lot of confusion on the matter of 'end times?'

## 1 There Are Three Different Camps

- **Praeterist**: the contents of the book of Revelation were only to do with 1st century church.
- **Historicist**: Until the mid 1800's this was the only view believed and accepted by protestant churches.
  - : There has already been a chronological fulfilment over the centuries of many of Revelation's prophecies.
  - : Revelation 1 19 are to do with this church age.
  - : Advocates include Wycliff, Luther, Tyndale, John Wesley, C.H. Spurgeon etc.
- **Futurist**: This would be the majority view of today's evangelical church.
  - : It claims Revelation 4 22 is nothing to do with the church age and is **ALL** future.
  - : That Christ's coming is a two stage coming, each coming separated by 7 years.
  - : This imagined 7 year period is considered to be 'Daniel's 70th week.'
  - : This arrangement implies 3 comings for Christ (the manger, the Rapture and then with the church.)
  - : Advocates include J.N. Darby, Hal Lindsey, Tim LayHaye/Barry Jenkins, John MacArthur.

## 2 The Founders/Fathers Of Futurism

- For over 1000 years Catholicism had kept the people in darkness and deprived of Scriptural light, they were fed godless superstition.
- On Wednesday 31st October 1517 God used a catholic priest to begin to 'turn the lights on.'
- Through reading the Bible the 'Reformers' made two earth shaking discoveries:
  - That salvation something that was 'received' by faith alone and NOT 'achieved' by human efforts.
  - That the dynasty or succession of popes fulfilled the criteria of the Bible's 'man of sin' mentioned in the book of Revelation.
- Subsequently multitudes 'came out' of Catholicism forming new 'protesting churches.'
- To stop the haemorrhaging of its people Rome launched its 'counter Reformation' headed by the Jesuits.
- Jesuits priests (Francisco Ribera, Cardinal Robert Bellarmine and Manuel Lacunza) formulated 'Futurism.'
- That all the prophecies in Revelation (including with regard to the antichrist)
  would only be fulfilled after the end of the church age thus letting papacy of the
  hook.
- **NB.** Up until 1830 this was a RC doctrine alien to Protestant and Evangelical churches.
- How did this Jesuit deception worm its way into the heart of evangelical church today?
- Lacunza's book 'The Coming Of The Messiah In Glory And Majesty' found its way into the library of the archbishop of Canterbury.
- The librarian (Samuel Roffey Maitland) was impressed by its ideas and began to publish tracts on it in church of England.
- A curate called John N. Darby was won over and he founded the 'Plymouth Brethren' churches.
- · He preached the notion throughout USA.
- He also persuaded C.I. Scoffield to include the ideas in the study notes of the 'Scoffield Reference Bible.'
- Inadvertently they have gathered a wild and poisonous gourd and mixed it in the pot of healthy Christian food.
